FAMILY MISSION TRIP TO HONDURAS APRIL 1 – 8, 2017

We are thrilled to invite you and your family to join our Family Mission Trip to Rancho el Paraiso this spring! Adults of all ages and children aged 10 and older accompanied by an adult relative are welcome to participate.

Adults and teens: \$800 per person • Children ages 10 – 12: \$400 per person

Included in the in-country fee are all meals (beginning with dinner on Saturday of your arrival through breakfast the following Saturday), lodging, Caves of Talgua tour, bi-lingual staff leadership, ground transportation, and materials/supplies for typical HOI work projects as well as some “younger kid friendly” projects!

Please note that each individual is responsible for purchasing their own airfare. Be sure to arrive into Toncontin Airport in Tegucigalpa by midday on Saturday, April 1st. Everyone must also have a valid passport (US passports must have a minimum of 180 days of validity remaining at the time of travel). The only meal not included in the in-country fees is lunch at the airport upon arrival, April 1st.
